SMF-SDO is supported by SPRING Singapore and endorsed by the Standards Council to manage the development, promotion and implementation of standards and to participate in relevant international standardisation activities for four Standards Committees.

These Standards Committees are Biomedical Standards Committee (BMSC), Food Standards Committee (FSC), General Engineering & Safety Standards Committee (GESSC) and Manufacturing Standards Committee (MSC).

Building on SMF's capability to engage partners, SMF-SDO has succeeded in identifying subject matter experts & stakeholders, and subsequently having them on board as Standard Partners. SMF-SDO has actively engaged the relevant expertise of more than 500 Standard Partners to date.

Working together with Standard Partners and SPRING Singapore, SMF-SDO has effectively administered the development and promotion of standards to meet the needs of the various industry sectors.

For the past year, SMF-SDO has completed 47 standard reviews & development as well as organised standards promotion & outreach events reaching out to more than 1200 participants.

Moving forward into the new term, SMF-SDO will also be conducting Standards Adoption Workshops for interested organisations that are keen on standards implementation.
